What my intent is today in His word, is to really, really, really encourage us in the greatness of God. There's no one greater than God. There's nothing greater than God. Good or bad, nothing is greater than God. So, that's the heart of what we're going to be discussing today in hearing from the Lord, is the greatness of God. We have a whole Bible that will tell us all about that, from Genesis to the end of Revelation. Then we have, personally, all of eternity. Now we're going to have to sit back and think on that one. It's one thing to sit down and read your Bible and pray. It's another thing to dwell with Almighty God forever and ever and ever and ever and ever. Everybody say, "Amen." So, this is the believers' hope. This is eternal life.

Wow, right now we see how great He is, but I know it's going to get better, because we will be with Him, and it won't be distant. He will have revealed Himself, and there's no end to the revelation of Jesus Christ. Just so you'll know, you know, He is eternal. So, I want us to always have that hope and that mindset in our day to day lives, that He is altogether lovely and He is our future. He is our hope, and He is great. We want God to reveal to us the greatness of His power. It's okay to ask God, "Reveal to me how great you are." He says, "Okay, read My word." That's a great start. Holy Ghost will continue every day to reveal how great God is in the Father, the Son, the Spirit, His word and all that He is. We have such a privilege to worship Him every day.

Today, I want to consider this and really think on these things. I want us to focus on greatness. Focus is very, very important in the Kingdom of Heaven. Every believer should have extraordinary focus, and that focus should not be on our studies, our work, our families, having to pay the bills, or life, or whatever it may be. Our focus will always be God, Jesus Christ, Holy Spirit, His Word and His Kingdom. That's our number one call. "Seek ye first the Kingdom of Heaven and His righteousness. Everything else will be added to us." So, that is our focus. We talk about focus a lot around here. You know, in this world, you have tribulation. He said, "But be of good cheer. I've overcome the world." He always brings us back to our focus on Him. He is the One, and He wants our focus on His greatness. Our resolve is to behold and know the glory of the Lord. We must focus on His greatness.

As we focus on the glory of the Lord, we're focusing on His greatness and all of His attributes. He's so good, isn't He? He's so, so good. All of His works are always great. There's not one work that you can say, "Well..." No, all of His works are great. You can see that in creation. Creation is a literal testimony to us. All of creation is a testimony to us. First Chronicles 16:25-27 NKJV

"For the Lord is great." You probably don't realize how many times you say this. If you know this scripture, you'll say, "The Lord is great and He's greatly to be praised." Even in your prayers, I can guarantee you, you're uttering that probably at least one time a week. It comes out of your spirit man, because the Lord is exalting His name. He is our Father, and Jesus is our Lord and our King. They are majestic. They are glorious. Our focus on the glory of God brings us in to see the majesty, the glory and the greatness of who He is. We have for all eternity. Maybe over yonder we will come up and say, "Dude, this is awesome," right? You just have to dream about it a little sometimes. Get outside of today and let your spirit soar, and know, wait a minute, this is real. He is real, and He is great. All glory and honor goes to Him, and I'm His. Whoah, say, "I'm His."

Psalm 145:3 NKJV

"Great is the Lord and greatly to be praised." Sound familiar? "His greatness is unsearchable." Oh, that abundance of love and majesty and revelation. I think it would do us good to contemplate on this more. What do you think? Yes, especially if you're going through a difficult time. This is a good time to give Him all the glory, honor and praise. Especially when you're waiting for that breakthrough in prayer for yourself or for another. Get in this river and exalt Him. John 14:25-28 NKJV

Jesus bore witness to His goodness and His grace. "Who is like you? Who shall not fear you, Lord, and glorify your name?" So, when we talk about the glory of God, and we say, "Lord, show me your glory," this is what the praise, just one little drop in the bucket, looks like to glorify His holy name forever. We're going to just fit right into Heaven, amen.

"All the nations will come and worship before Him." That is a definite amen. I'm just saying, all nations and all people groups. Yes, all nations, every tongue, kindred and tribe, shall glorify God and worship before Him. They will proclaim His greatness. You know what, we've all come through from one generation to the next, and all will have a very powerful focus. "Great is the Lord and greatly to be praised." Amen. "His greatness is unsearchable." I want us to remember this all the way through the end of the year, especially. Let it be as you gather in your families and celebrate the King Jesus and His birth. How great He is.

Job 5:9 NKJV

“God, who does great things and unsearchable marvelous things without number.” This is in a statement. This is in part of conversation, “God, who does great things and unsearchable marvelous things without number.” See, that's right in the middle of life. It's right in the middle of humanity's conflict on the Earth. It's right in the middle of humans walking through stuff. It's right in the middle of not understanding fully everything that's really gone on. But, there is a voice. “This is God, who does great things.” Hear it? “Unsearchable, marvelous things without number.” You just stepped into eternal praise. This is in the book of Job. You can read all of Job at home for fun.

Psalm 9:1 NKJV

This is the believers call. If you've been born again from above, from the eldest to the youngest, this is our charge, our duty, our sovereign duty. Yes, before God, in all that we do. We give God our highest praise. “I will praise you, O Lord.” If you just go around your day saying that, it will change everything. “I will praise you, Lord with my whole heart. I will tell of all your marvelous works.” Sometimes we can't keep that to ourselves. We've got to tell somebody else. That's why we testify, amen. “I will praise you, O Lord.”

Job 36:5 NKJV

In the book of Job, one of Job's friends speaks of the greatness of God. “Behold, God is mighty, but despises no one. Job 36:24-33 NKJV

He's recognizing, in the midst of disaster, calamity, destruction on the Earth and all that goes on, to magnify the Lord. For the human to look up and know that, “God Almighty, O, He is Lord of all. He is so great. He is so great, and yet we don't even know Him.” You understand? But, “I feel Him. I sense Him. I see Him. Job 37:1-24 NKJV

Did you know that this was written by the great Holy Ghost? Inspiration was given to humans. This is the glory of the Lord to be revealed from one generation to the next. He cares about you. He cares about your story. He's speaking of His greatness in your story, in your life, and in your journey. He wants to magnify His great name. He wants us to, “Look up and know that our redemption draws near.” Yes, daily, “I die daily, so that He might live,” amen.

Job 42:1-6 NKJV

“Then Job answered the Lord.” This is at the end of the book, by the way. “Then Job answered the Lord, and he said, “I know that you can do everything, and no purpose of yours can be withheld from you.” Wow, who told him that? Flesh and blood did not reveal this to him. He went through it. Job answers the Lord and says, “I know you can do everything and that no purpose of yours can be withheld from you.” That makes Him the Lord God, almighty and marvelous. “Oh greatly to be praised is your name.” Wow.

Verse three, "You asked, 'Who is this who hides counsel without knowledge?' Therefore I have uttered what I did not understand. Things too wonderful me, which I did not know. Listen, please, and let me speak. You said, 'I will question you, and you shall answer Me.' "I have heard of you by the hearing of the ear, but now my eyes see you. Therefore I abhor myself and repent in dust and ashes."

Humanity just met an almighty God through a situation that he didn't sign up for when he was born, and who started as the most blessed man on the planet, *which is an understatement*. Through it all, there's a greater glory coming. There was a humbling with humans, with mankind, all through it. "This is how I was perceiving, and I was standing the best I could. I was trying to figure everything out on this journey. But, I have this conclusion. I have only heard, I have only now seen the truth, and everything is you. Everything is about you. These things are too marvelous for me to even fully understand." That God brought a revelation, the Spirit of understanding came to humans to be able to encounter Almighty God. He has not stopped.

John 10:29-30 NKJV

Second Corinthians 4:6 NKJV

He has shone in our heart, because you believe in your heart and confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord. Amen, that's how we're saved. “He gives us light of the knowledge of the glory of God, in the face of Christ. First John 1:1-2 NKJV
