

# Hidden Now and Forever

Sermon transcript May 31, 2026

What a real blessing, you know, that we have received the Kingdom of Heaven and that the Lord has really chosen to abide with us, His children. That is amazing. It's miraculous. And it's His will. And we're right in the middle of His will, yes. No matter where we are in our journey of life, He will never leave us. Thank God.

Say He'll never leave me. Never leave me. Oh, my goodness. Well, I titled this Hidden Now and Forever. Lord Jesus, bless it and let everybody understand the intent of Your heart.

Go to John 3. John 3:15. God is good. John 3:15: that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have eternal life. Verse 16: For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life. Verse 17: For God did not send His Son into the world to condemn the world, but that the world through Him might be saved.

Whoever believes in Him should not perish but have eternal life. Whoever believes in Him should not perish but have eternal life. That's the goal, yes? To live eternally with God, with Jesus, with the Holy Ghost in the Kingdom of Heaven, amen. Whoever believes in Jesus Christ will not perish. So eternal life is the goal, yes? Forever and ever and ever and ever, amen.

With Him, never without Him again. What a promise. And this is how every one of us got saved was this verse right here. We went through this door to be saved. Every one of us, if you believe in your heart, confess with your mouth, Jesus is Lord, you shall be saved. Every one of us stepped through this door. And Jesus says, I'm the door, okay?

Every one of us began here, but yet it is an eternal promise. It is astounding to me. This was step one for the baby to take, to simply believe these words. We stepped through the door into heaven, Jesus Christ. And eternal life became, is now within us because our spirit has been born again from above, correct? And it will never end.

This is the door and the goal is forever and ever and ever and without end, amen, amen. That eternal life with God, which is good to think on, not just near death or when you're sick and afraid of dying, right? This should be our daily bread of the joy set before us of what is ours by inheritance forever. To think upon the things that the Father has given to us freely. That's amazing. That's why we have this Bible. He's so good to us, isn't He?

Now go to Colossians 3:10. I'm going to read this out of the Passion Translation. We are hidden now and forever. Colossians 3:10. He says, For you have acquired new creation life, which is

continually being renewed into the likeness of the one who created you, giving you the full revelation of God.

For you have acquired new creation life. Say, I have acquired new creation life, which is continually being renewed. Okay, it is continually being renewed into the likeness of the one who created you. That's amazing, giving you the full revelation of God. That's why now we see in part, we know in part, but then say face to face.

And Jesus made a way for this to happen. Jesus' blood made the way to bring new creation life that is continually being renewed. We are continually being changed. We are continually being transformed into the image and likeness of the One, yes? You have acquired new creation life. And eternal life starts now. It's continually being renewed. It's new. His mercies are new every morning into the likeness of the one. That's the goal.

The likeness of the one, Jesus, who created you, giving you the full revelation of God. Jesus Christ has a full revelation of God the Father. Jesus Christ has full revelation of Holy Spirit. And the Father and the Holy Ghost have full revelation of Jesus Christ the Son. They know who They are. And Their job is to reveal to us, the church, who They are.

And you come through the door of salvation so we will not perish to see eternal life now, and it's a journey of love. And for all eternity, we get to bask in that glory and that promise. Amen. It's just not a cheap ticket to heaven, right? Get out of hell. It is a glorious, glorious revelation of the future and the inheritance that we have with God in Christ. This is amazing.

Revelation 1:4–6. This is Jesus talking to the churches. And I'm going to start in verse 4. John, to the seven churches which are in Asia: grace to you and peace from Him who is and who was and who is to come, and from the seven spirits who are before His throne, and from Jesus Christ, the faithful witness, the firstborn from the dead, and the ruler over the kings of the earth.

To Him who loved us and washed us from our sins in His own blood, and has made us kings and priests to His God and Father, to Him be glory and dominion forever and ever. Amen. To the Church of Jesus Christ then, now, and forever, grace and peace is being multiplied to us from Him who is and was and is to come.

We are a new creation life. We are continually being renewed into the likeness of the one who created us. I'm not the same today as I was yesterday. Truth. If you're alive and you've been born again, the Holy Ghost is changing you every single day. Amen. Say amen. Amen. Say I'm not stuck. I'm not stuck. Okay.

He's empowering us to see His dominion and His glory, beloved. He is faithful. He's the faithful witness, the firstborn from the dead. He's the ruler over all the kings of the earth now. Say now. Now. He who loved us and washed us from our sins in His very own blood. This is what He has done and has made us kings and priests to His God and Father. That's an inheritance. That is glorious. This is miraculous.

You're not just saved. You're not just a good Christian, right? He's making us kings and priests to His God and Father. We are kings and priests. This is dominion, okay? This is not just I'm in the family. This is we are a part of the kingdom of heaven serving God Almighty as Jesus Christ is serving God Almighty. As He is, so are we in this world. And it begins here. He has made us kings and priests to our God forever.

We are allowed to go before the throne of grace forever. We're allowed to be with God forever. We are going to be with God forever and ever, amen. We've got a whole Bible for this, yes? This is good news. This is your inheritance.

But we're not just going to go to heaven and eat grapes, okay? I mean, there is glory here. Okay, there's a new creation. God alone knows what He has planned for us, yes? We get tastes in the Scripture. But it's glorious and it's good news, and He's changing the way we're thinking now.

What are we saying here now all morning? Here, now. Here, now. I'm stepping into this now, by faith and by revelation. He's given me full revelation of God. He's renewing me to give me full revelation of God. He is renewing me every day to have full revelation of God. And I want that. I want that every day.

And as we read the Word, we are transformed. That's why we need to open the Bible and read it. When we open it and read it, it comes in our eye gate, our heart, our spirit man is up front and center receiving the revelation of God and Jesus and the Holy Ghost and His Kingdom. When you read the Word of God, you're not just doing your duty. You are talking to God and He is talking to you.

When you read the Word of God, you are being developed by the Spirit of grace. He is empowering you, He's delivering you, He's healing you, He's setting you securely with Him in heavenly places. He's giving you hope and a future. Amen?

Let's look at Jesus Christ here in Luke 1. We are hidden now and forever in Him. And we have received eternal life and we are receiving eternal life. We are being renewed. I have acquired life and life more abundantly. I'm a new creation, okay? The old is gone, the Scripture says. Hallelujah. We're continually being renewed into the likeness of God. That's it. We are continually being renewed. So when He comes to you, just yield. Just submit. Just surrender. Just say, yes, Lord. Yes?

Luke 1:26. Okay, here we go. So it says, now in the sixth month, the angel Gabriel was sent by God to a city of Galilee named Nazareth, to a virgin betrothed to a man whose name was Joseph, of the house of David. Verse 28: And having come in, the angel said to her, Rejoice, highly favored one, the Lord is with you. Blessed are you among women.

And when she saw him, she was troubled at His saying and considered what manner of greeting this was. Verse 30: Then the angel said to her, Do not be afraid, Mary, for you have found favor with God. And behold, you will conceive in your womb and bring forth a Son, and shall call His

name Jesus. He will be great and will be called the Son of the Highest, and the Lord God will give Him the throne of His father David. And He will reign over the house of Jacob forever, and of His kingdom there will be no end.

This is kingdom dominion starting here. We don't just read this when we celebrate the Lord's birth. Amen? This is a testimony of the glory of God at the sovereign moment, at just the right minute, to show Himself to this virgin Mary, saying, now is the time. Okay, that's where it's at, right there. This new creation movement started right here.

And wow, did He start big into a virgin, yes? And the Spirit of God came upon her and this is the truth that will come forth. And He says, this virgin is betrothed to a man whose name was Joseph of the house of David. Everything is perfect in the lineage and the call of Jesus Christ according to God's will and His creation. Amen?

The angels are rejoicing. The angel is excited. Rejoice, highly favored one. I think he says this to her because he was rejoicing. I don't think angels are boring, do you? I mean, rejoice. This is awesome. You know, Texas style. Highly favored one, the Lord's with you. You're so blessed among all women.

You hear heaven rejoicing here. And I bet he had a whole bunch of angels behind him just reverberating with yes and amen. Okay? Whew. Verse 31: you're going to conceive in your womb and bring forth the Son. His name will be Jesus. How powerful is that? He will be great. I want you to hear this. He will be great. He will be called the Son of the Highest. And the Lord God will give Him the throne of His father David. He's going to reign over the house of Jacob forever and of His kingdom there will be no end.

Good. Now go to Revelation 19:16. Pretty simple statement. This is the end of the book. This is of Jesus Christ and who He's speaking of. And it says, And He has on His robe and on His thigh a name written: KING OF KINGS AND LORD OF LORDS.

Okay, right here it didn't just say He was of the throne of His father David. We're going to get to that in a minute. He is King of kings, yes? He is Lord of lords. And He came through the lineage of the throne of David as per God's command. Truth? There's some dominion here. Because you have acquired new creation life, which is continually being renewed into the likeness of the one who created you, giving you full revelation of God.

I'm receiving full revelation of God. And He is King of kings and He is Lord of lords. And when you have a bad day, you just start praying that and decreeing who He is. Jesus Christ is King of kings and Lord of lords. I say it a lot. Jesus is King, okay? And He just conquers hell that's coming against you.

Jesus Christ shall rule forever as King of the entire world and government. Oh, I know He's eager. We're eager. But everything according to the Father's will and plan. Amen. Now look at

Zechariah 14:9. The prophet is speaking of Jesus. And it says, And the Lord shall be King over all the earth. In that day it shall be: The Lord is one, and His name one.

Hear, O Israel, the Lord your God is one, right? And the Lord shall be King, capital K. This speaks of the Christ of what I'm just speaking to you now. The Lord shall be King over all the earth. Not just in Israel, right? Over all of the earth, which is the place of dominion that God put mankind. Truth?

Scout down to Zechariah 14:17. It shall come to pass that everyone who is left of all the nations which came against Jerusalem shall go up from year to year to worship the King, the Lord of hosts, and to keep the Feast of Tabernacles. And it shall be that whichever of the families of the earth do not come up to Jerusalem to worship the King, the Lord of Hosts, on them there shall be no rain.

This is the millennial reign of Christ, okay? It shall come to pass that everyone who's left of all the nations that came against Jerusalem shall go up from year to year to worship the King, right? The Lord of hosts forever and ever at the Feast of Tabernacles.

Now, go to Psalm 5:12. We are called to be hidden in the Lord our God. I am receiving revelation of who He is. And when I read these Scriptures of eternal life and revelation of God and what's being renewed in me day by day by the King of Glory Himself, when I see His story, when I see that He loved us and washed us from our sins in His own blood, and that He made us kings and priests to His God forever and ever, I am entering into revelation knowledge of eternal life, of eternal dominion, of eternal rule in God in Christ.

He is renewing our mind. We are forever hidden in Him, now and forevermore, yes, now and forevermore. Verse 12: He says, You, Lord, will bless the righteous; with favor You will surround him as with a shield. You, Lord, will bless—say, me. You, Lord, will bless the righteous; with favor You will surround him as with a shield.

Now go to Psalm 27. We are forever hidden in this King. And eternal life starts now. That's why Jesus said, pray this way: Our Father who art in heaven, holy is Your name. Thy kingdom come, Thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven. That's how He starts this whole thing out. And it's not going to end. Amen.

Psalm 27:1. This is a Psalm of David. The Lord is my light and my salvation; whom shall I fear? The Lord is the strength of my life; of whom shall I be afraid? When the wicked came against me to eat up my flesh, my enemies and foes, they stumbled and fell. Though an army may encamp against me, my heart shall not fear. Though war may rise against me, in this I will be confident.

Verse 4. One thing I have desired of the Lord, that will I seek: that I may dwell in the house of the Lord all the days of my life, to behold the beauty of the Lord and to inquire in His temple.

Verse 5: For in the time of trouble He shall hide me in His pavilion; in the secret place of His

tabernacle He shall hide me; He shall set me high upon a rock. And now my head shall be lifted up above my enemies all around me.

Therefore I will offer sacrifices of joy in His tabernacle; I will sing, yes, I will sing praises to the Lord. Hear, O Lord, when I cry with my voice; have mercy upon me and answer me. And when You said, Seek My face, my heart said to You, Your face, Lord, I will seek.

What agreement. This is of the house of David. You understand? This is the lineage of where the Christ is coming from, of a man who was called out in a bloodline for such a time as this and that and forevermore. And this is one little piece of his journey, learning to abide and dwell in tabernacle with God as a warrior and eventually the king of Israel. You understand? I'm just saying. This is a story.

And as you read all the works of David, you will see the journey of what we're talking about here. You will see the journey of love for him before Christ came. Truth. You set me high upon the rock. He shall hide me. Okay, so obviously he is a warrior, he is seeking God, he's overcoming the enemies, he understands, he's telling the whole story here before the Lord, and his confidence is one thing I've asked of God, and that's what I'm going to seek.

I will dwell in the house of God all the days of my life. I'll behold the Lord in all His beauty. He shifts everything and steps into the eternal purpose. He is hidden in God already, yes? He is going to behold Him and inquire, especially in times of trouble. Especially in times of trouble. He will hide me in His pavilion, in the secret place.

We are hidden with God in the secret place. He knows everything about you. Tell Him everything about you. Talk to Him. Tell Him everything. Do not hold back, yes? You should be telling Him way more things than you're telling the brother, sister, spouse, preacher, you understand? You should be telling God everything. He knows it already. Yeah. But He wants you to talk to Him. He wants you to seek refuge in Him. Yes? He's our first. He's everything.

You tell Him everything, the good, the bad, and the ugly. That's it. He's our Father, yes? Hallelujah. He shall hide me and set me high upon the rock. There's a fortress here. There's a hidden place. There's a place of refuge here. There's a strong tower here, yes? And my head is lifted above all my enemies. You see it.

And I'm going to praise, praise, praise and worship the Lord, because He knew where His help came from. And He says, when You said, Seek My face, well, my heart said, You bet I'm going to seek Your face. And that's our call now, yes? To seek His face. We are called to be hidden in the Lord our God. He is King.

Now look at Psalm 32:7. You are my hiding place; You shall preserve me from trouble; You shall surround me with songs of deliverance. Selah. You are my hiding place, Lord. Yes. You shall, covenant word, preserve me from trouble, whatever that may be. You shall, covenant word, surround me with songs of deliverance.

That doesn't just mean that the Holy Spirit gave David songs of deliverance. It means that God is singing deliverance over him. It means Jesus is singing songs of deliverance over him. Your High King, High Priest is singing songs of worship and praise and adoration to the Father over His creation, over the one. And we are hidden in Him. We are hidden in Him, yes, forever.

We're called to be hidden in Him, known in Him, found in Him. This is the glory of the Lord. You are my hiding place and it's not just when we're in trouble. This is daily abiding, yes? And because of this, You shall preserve me. Sozo, salvation, right? There's a protection there. That is part of salvation and what it means.

You shall surround me with songs of deliverance because it's always following us everywhere we go, because God is working this incredible, eternal, glorious work in us, and we have to come in tune with that. Well, I don't know how it works anymore, but used to, the radio, you know, we'd have to find the station until it hit right. Does anybody know what I'm talking about? I'm really old.

Okay, so you find it, and there it is, but until then it's not real clear. But you know when you hit the target, and then the songs start coming through loud and clear, right? You get it? The Lord is my hiding place. Hide out with Him. Go get in the cave with Him. Go get in the street with Him. Go get in the tree with Him. Lie down on your bed. Get under the couch. Sit still and know that He is Lord. Be with Him, yes? Open the Word and let Him come in there, yeah?

Look at Psalm 119. That's a big one. We're going to read all of it today. No, just kidding. Psalm 119:114. I'm going to read this out of the Passion Translation. It just sounded good. Psalm 119:114. I am hidden now and forever. Y'all there?

Verse 114: You're my place of quiet retreat, and Your wraparound presence becomes my shield as I wrap myself up in Your word. You're my place of quiet retreat, and Your wraparound presence becomes my shield as I wrap myself in Your word. Wow. Go away, leave me all you workers of wickedness. You can't stop me from following every command of my God.

Wow. Lord, strengthen my inner being by the promises of Your word so that I may live faithful and unashamed for You. Lift me up and I will be safe. Empower me to live every moment in the light of Your ways. Can I read it again? It's glorious.

You're my place of quiet retreat, and Your wraparound presence becomes my shield as I wrap myself in Your word. Thou, O Lord, art a shield about me, yes, and the glory and the lifter of my head. My place of quiet retreat, Your wraparound presence becomes my shield as I wrap myself in Your word. Say, as one. I'm in Him and He's in me and He is wrapped around us, yes? His glory presence within, without, around, above, below, beneath. I'm in Him and He's in me.

I'm a new creation, continually being renewed into the likeness of the one who created me and has given me full revelation of God, daily. Go away, leave me all you workers of wickedness,

you dumb demons and lies, right? You can't stop me from following every command of my God. You see the authority that comes out of that place, the confidence that comes out of that place.

Lord, strengthen my inner being by the promises of Your word so that I can live faithful and unashamed for You. You hear this abiding, you see the hiding, you hear the I'm telling Him everything, and He tells the Lord and the Lord tells him. He tells the Lord, the Lord brings revelation to him. And he speaks what God is saying. He speaks out what God is singing. He speaks what the angels are delivering. And he just thinks he's praying and writing these beautiful prayers and songs, yes? Communion. Say communion.

Lift me up and I will be safe. Empower me to live every moment in the light of Your ways. Every moment. That's our lifestyle, beloved. Now go to Psalm 61. I'm reading this out of the Passion Translation, the whole Psalm. Hallelujah.

Psalm 61:1–3. O God, hear my prayer. Listen to my heart's cry. For no matter where I am, even when I'm far from home, I will cry out to You for a Father's help. And when I'm feeble and overwhelmed by life, guide me into glory where I'm safe and sheltered. Verse 3: Lord, You are a paradise, a protection to me. You lift me high above the fray. None of my foes can touch me when I am held firmly in Your wraparound presence.

Keep me in this glory. Let me live continually under Your splendor shadow, hiding my life in You forever. You have heard my sweet resolutions to love and serve You, for I am Your beloved. You have given me an inheritance of rich treasures, which You give to all of Your devoted lovers.

You treat me like a king, giving me a full and abundant life, years and years of reigning, like many generations rolled into one. Verse 7: I will live enthroned with You forever. So guard me, God, with Your unending, unfailing love. Let me live my days, walking in grace and truth before You. And my praises will fill the heavens forever, fulfilling my vow to make every day a love gift to You.

Same David. You understand? Hear my prayer. My God, listen to my heart's cry. The heart, the soul. He knows where we are. He knows our need. He knows our wrestling. He knows our struggles. He knows the goodness. He sees the glory. He sees the destiny, the purpose. He sees who you are. And He knows this. He can say, God, I know You're here. Listen to my heart.

So when you go to the Lord in prayer, He's listening to your heart speak. You understand? Truth? It's not just a ritualistic prayer to get in the door, okay? No matter where I am, even when I'm far away from home, I will cry out to You for a Father's help. When I'm feeble and overwhelmed by life, guide me into Your glory where I'm safe and sheltered. It's a story of life. It's a story of life every day.

You're a paradise of protection to me. I love that. Lift me high above the fray. None of my foes can touch me. You see when he gets into the truth, yes? He acknowledges what the Spirit of God

is saying in his own heart, and then you see when the truth lands with authority and dominion. None of my foes can touch me because I'm held firmly. I'm kept in Him. I am forever hidden in Him. Every day. Every day. Not just when troubles come. Yes, every day I'm held firmly.

Keep me in this glory, Lord. Keep me in this glory, Lord. Keep me in this glory, Lord. Let me live continually under Your splendor shadow, hiding my life in You forever. You are my hiding place, my rock, my fortress, my strong tower and salvation. We are being formed into new creation as kings and priests, and it starts here. And this is the testimony of creation, testimony of mankind, looking for help, looking for God. And this one knows God even before Jesus Christ. Amen?

You have given me an inheritance of rich treasures which You give to all Your devoted lovers. We all have been given inheritance in God. We can't take that for granted because it's going to outdo anything on the earth's inheritance. Truth. Our inheritance is God in Christ forever and ever. Amen.

I will live enthroned with You forever. We're going to reign and reign and rule and rule. You treat me like a king now. I'm a king. You're giving me full and abundant life, years and years of reigning. You understand it? Like many generations rolled into one, I will live enthroned with You forever. That is the inheritance the saints have in Christ, the King of kings, the Lord of lords that I talked about, who has all dominion, authority, and power, who has made us kings and priests unto our God, and it starts today. It starts now. It starts by revelation of the God that you're serving and revelation of you having your heart just totally consumed with Him and allowing Him to have all of it. Amen.

Verse 7: I will live enthroned with You forever. Guard me, God, with Your unending, unfailing love. Let me live my days walking in grace and truth before You, and my praises will fill the heavens forever. When you praise the Lord, it does fill all of the heavens forever and ever. Just, I love you, Lord. Who knows what that looks like in the Spirit? The high praises, thankfulness. You delivered me, God. Thank You for granting me repentance, right? That's how we got in, is through repentance. And it doesn't change as He is changing and transforming us. My praises will fill the heavens. So when we're praising, we have to see it's a bigger work. If you look at the whole Church Global on a 24-hour clock, there are some praises filling heaven, yes?

Now go to Ezekiel 34. This is going forward a bit, looking at the future millennial reign of King David and Jesus Christ's eternal kingdom. We spoke of him earlier, from one generation to the next, from step to step and glory to glory. Wow. Jesus is King.

Ezekiel 34:23. This is where we're going to start. Y'all good? All right, it says, I will establish one shepherd over them, and he shall feed them, My servant David. He shall feed them and be their shepherd. And I, the Lord, will be their God, and My servant David a prince among them. I, the Lord, have spoken.

Verse 25: I will make a covenant of peace with them and cause wild beasts to cease from the land, and they will dwell safely in the wilderness and sleep in the woods. Verse 26: I will make them and the places all around My hill a blessing. I will cause showers to come down in their season; there shall be showers of blessing. Then the trees of the field shall yield their fruit, and the earth shall yield her increase, and they shall be safe in their land, and they shall know that I am the Lord.

When I have broken the bands of their yoke and delivered them from the hand of those who enslaved them, they shall no longer be a prey for the nations, nor shall beasts of the land devour them, but they shall dwell safely, and no one shall make them afraid. I will raise up for them a garden of renown. They shall no longer be consumed with hunger in the land, nor bear the shame of the Gentiles anymore.

Thus they shall know that I, the Lord their God, am with them, and they, the house of Israel, are My people, says the Lord God. You are My flock, the flock of My pasture. You are men, and I am your God, says the Lord God. Amen.

Look at Ezekiel 37:24. You have acquired new creation life, which is continually being renewed into the likeness of the one who created you, giving you full revelation of God. Well, Israel is going to come into full revelation of God, okay? All the way through the line. Yes, He knows what He's doing. Yes?

Ezekiel 37:24. This is for real, okay? David My servant shall be king over them. Like, are you serious? There's the same guy over here with the sheep, you know—where did he start from? He has a word, he has a will, he has a plan. I will forever be hidden in Him, yes? I take my shelter in Him.

And the whole journey of his life and where the Messiah was going to come from, out of that lineage, yes, out of that family, yes, you understand? Here we are. David My servant shall be king over them. They shall all have one shepherd. They shall all walk in My judgments and observe My statutes and actually do them.

Verse 25: Then they shall dwell in the land that I have given to Jacob My servant, where your fathers dwelt. And they shall dwell there: they, their children, and their children's children forever. And My servant David shall be their prince forever. Moreover I will make a covenant of peace with them, and it shall be an everlasting covenant with them. I will establish them and multiply them, and I will set My sanctuary in their midst forevermore.

Verse 27: My tabernacle also shall be with them. Indeed I will be their God, and they shall be My people. The nations also will know finally that I, the Lord, sanctify Israel, when My sanctuary is in their midst forever. These are promises, prophecies, and these are things that shall be fulfilled in Jesus' name. Amen? From start to finish.

We are being asked to step into the glory of the Lord and recognize His presence and His eternal mandate on the earth. These are testimonies of what is to come. These are testimonies of what has been. These are testimonies of the Lord God Almighty, of King Jesus Himself, and who He calls us to be in Him, because we are one in Him forever. Amen?

Go to Revelation 5. I'll close here. We're hidden with Him now and forever. So it's like, oh Lord, You are my hiding place. You know, yes, let Him be your hiding place now. Because here's the place of intimacy. Here's the place of glory. I'm just reading you a few testimonies. But it stirs your spirit. It's like, I want that. I want that revelation. I know now how to go to the Lord. And it's not a religious duty. Amen? It's life-giving.

Verse 8: Now when He had taken the scroll, the four living creatures and the twenty-four elders fell down before the Lamb, Jesus, each having a harp, and golden bowls full of incense, which are the prayers of the saints. And they sang a new song: You are worthy to take the scroll, and to open its seals, because You were slain, and have redeemed us to God by Your blood out of every tribe and tongue and people and nation, and have made us kings and priests to our God; and we shall reign on the earth.

Wow. He took the scroll and the four heavenly living creatures and the twenty-four elders in heaven fell down before the King, the Lamb, Jesus, each having a harp and golden bowls full of incense. We're always overflowing with praise and worship and adoration and pouring out your soul to God. And as you pour out your soul to God, He pours into you who He is for you. Right?

It's not just a list of prayers from the saints. It is the abiding. I will live in You. I will abide in You. I will be hidden in You. I'm in You and You're in me. And we are in the glory of the Lord every day. Say every day. Every day. That's true.

And they sang a new song: O Lord, You are worthy to take the scroll and open the seals because You were slain. You've redeemed us to God by Your blood. That's absolutely phenomenal. Amen.

Stand up. I pray you have ears to hear and may the Holy Ghost speak to our hearts. Lord God, we say yes. We adore You. We know that through our Jesus, You have given us eternal life and it starts today. And we are hidden with You. You are working overtime to bring revelation knowledge of who You are. And we receive, Father, revelation knowledge today.

Remove every hindrance, every block, remove every veil, all pride, and that we would come and hide ourselves, hide ourselves, hide ourselves in You. Open up, open up, open up, open up all the hearts, the souls, the minds, the wills, emotions to fully step through the blood, through the veil, and enter into the presence of God where Your glory dwells.

And Lord, we know that You will strengthen us in that place. Whether we're soaring and high or whether we're low and despondent or crying in need, You will always reveal Your glory to us.
