

Mighty to Save

Sermon transcript - July 12th, 2026

Lord, okay. Well, I'm entitled this Mighty to Save. I'm going to pray over this word. And may our hearts and our ears hear what He's saying to us.

So Father, we just thank You for this glorious morning and how good it is when we can come together in unity and gather around Your Spirit and Your Word and honor You and love You and pour out our heart to You. Thank You for the privilege. Actually, You commanded us not to neglect gathering, and we are so grateful that You've called us to Yourself.

And I ask, Lord, that You would open ears and the heart and the eyes to understand and see the heart of Your message today. You are mighty and our God, and we love You in Jesus' name. Amen. Amen.

All right. Well, last we got kind of started on this and told everybody that we'd be speaking on the Spirit of Might for a little bit. And so if you could go to Isaiah 11:2-3.

Isaiah 11:2-3, this speaks of our Messiah, the Christ, Jesus Christ, and the fullness of the Holy Spirit that lives and rests upon Him. Isaiah 11:2-3, it says, the Spirit of the Lord will rest on Him, the Spirit of wisdom and of understanding, the Spirit of counsel and of might, and the spirit of the knowledge and of the fear of the Lord, and He will delight in the fear of the Lord.

This is who our Jesus is, and this is the mantle and the anointing and the power and the glory that He carries. Jesus Christ, our merciful Lord and Savior, He has complete and total dominion. He conquered hell, death, and the grave on the cross, yes. He was raised from the dead on the third day, yes. He ascended into heaven and He's coming again.

We as believers cannot forget that He's coming again. This is as much as our salvation. We hope for this blessed hope. Yes, we long for His appearing. And every day in our lives is an opportunity to know Him deeply and intimately.

He is cloaked in, filled with the fullness of Holy Spirit. He lacks nothing. Your Lord lacks nothing. Our God lacks nothing. There's nothing that our God cannot do. The journey of love on this side of life is coming to know Him and receive from Him and accept what He's done for us. Amen. That's a daily journey, yes?

The Spirit of the Lord will rest upon Him. He is anointed, He is called, He is chosen. He carries the fullness of Holy Spirit's wisdom. He carries the fullness. He does not lack anything. Jesus Christ lacks nothing.

Truth, the spirit of wisdom and understanding, the spirit of counsel and of might. the spirit of knowledge and of the fear of the Lord, and it said that His delight was in the fear of the Lord.

So we know and we have spoken that the fear of the Lord is the beginning of all wisdom and knowledge. The fear of the Lord was His greatest delight. Jesus Christ feared God the Father. That's holy. Say holy. He is so good. And He submitted to the Father's will perfectly. That was His greatest delight.

So if that was His greatest delight, then I want that to be my greatest delight. Christians' greatest delight would be to fear the Lord. That's holy, it's healthy, yes. And without Him, we would be doomed eternally into hell. Our sins wouldn't be forgiven, right? I don't have to pay for my own, and neither do you.

So we're so thankful that Jesus Christ did. And it was because of the fear of the Lord that He was sent, and God didn't send Him without power. God sent His Son into the world, yes, born into humanity, but He was full, overflowing, perfect in Holy Spirit. Perfect. He didn't lack anything. He never sinned. Do you understand? And He obeyed the Lord. He obeyed the Lord. Father, not my will, but Your will be done. That's the fear of the Lord, you see.

So we exalt Jesus here. We lift Him really high. We don't want to exalt religion. We don't want to exalt human effort and pride. We want to exalt King Jesus. Amen.

So the fullness of the Holy Spirit. So when you hear that, that's the sevenfold Spirit of God, the fullness of Holy Ghost resting upon and within and through Jesus Christ. Now Jesus Christ has a body and Jesus is the head. We are the body. We are the church.

So that fullness. That fullness is called to continue to rest on the body of Christ. Right? Not just one person or two or a special group. You understand? From the moment that He left, when He breathed into them, all the way until the end, this fullness is resting upon the body of Christ from one generation to the next in order to accomplish the Father's will until He says He's coming again.

That's encouraging. Yes? That is very encouraging. It strengthens us. Yes? The scripture says, strengthen the knees that are feeble. And God's might will strengthen the knees that are feeble. God will strengthen us through His might. And He's been encouraging us in the spirit of might. The spirit of might.

Most have heard of the man of God named Samson in the Old Testament. We spoke of that last week. That doesn't mean that we all walk around in our Samson and doing these mighty feats. But yet if He calls you to that, then there's going to be might there, right?

But the Spirit of might empowers us every day, and the body of Christ does mighty works. No matter what He calls us to do from the north-south, east to west, and every point in between, we don't know everything God's doing around the globe with every person. Now, He does. right? Nor do they know what He's doing in us. They're like, wow, you know? You have to understand, we were all hidden in Christ.

So this is our verse, and we honor the Spirit of might. He continues to exhort us. The lion from the tribe of Judah will never forsake us. He'll never leave us, never fail us, never forsake us. That is good news.

You should get up every day and say, thank You, Father. You will never leave me, fail me, or forsake me. Can y'all practice? Father? You'll never leave me, fail me, or forsake me. Okay?

We are called to live by God's divine strength, okay? He is God. He is divine. And so we are called to live by that strength every day. And you know that we need it. You know where you need strength, not just physical strength, but spiritual, mental, yes, emotional, resolve, courage. We need His strength every day, if you're human, all right?

We are called by His divine strength. Look at Ephesians 6:10-13. Good news. It says, Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord and in the power of His might. And then verse 13, he says, Therefore take up the whole armor of God, that you may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand.

In between there is what we call the armor of God. Okay? He compares us to soldiers, yes, the armor that they walk in and war in and walk in every day, yes, in their job. He calls us to be clothed in the armor of His light, clothed in might.

Be strong in the Lord and the strength of His might. You hear it? Finally, my brethren, body of Christ, be strong in the Lord and in the power of His might. So we have access to His might. I have access to His strength. I have access to His obedience. I have access to the fullness. I have access to counsel that moves with might.

Every day, God counsels us. Don't just think a little, what do you call it? Meeting with someone to get some counsel. Yes? He is the counselor. Yes? The Spirit of God is the counsel, and He counsels us, and counsel moves with might. Beautiful.

Yes, take up the whole armor of God that you can stand in the evil day. That you can stand in the evil day, having done all, stand. So that is a charge to the body of Christ from then all

the way until the end. Having done all, stand. Stand fast, be strong in the Lord and the strength of His might. You hear this, you just hear the strength in that scripture, yes?

Now go to Jeremiah 32:17. And I have this out of NIV. God is mighty to save. Thank the Lord that we are born again and that we have this great God. Say, I'm not alone.

Jeremiah 32:17-19. Ah, sovereign Lord, You have made the heavens and the earth by Your great power and Your outstretched arm. Nothing is too hard for You. You show love to thousands, but You bring the punishment for the parents' sins into the laps of their children after them. Great and mighty God, whose name is the Lord Almighty, Great are Your purposes, and mighty are Your deeds. Your eyes are open to the ways of all mankind, and You will reward each person according to the conduct and their deeds deserve.

That's strong. As spoken by Jeremiah the prophet, it's the word of the Lord straight off the press. It's worship, it's a declaration, God's revealing to us who our God is. Sovereign Lord, You have made the heavens and the earth by Your great power. That's might. You have made the heaven and earth by Your great power an outstretched arm. Nothing is too hard for You.

And when we meditate on these words and apply them to our lives, you feel strengthened. Counsel comes to meet you where you're at. and bring the might of the Lord into your situations, physical, emotional, spiritual, relational, and your walk with God.

God never designed for us to walk alone, ever, right? We're supposed to be together. He's with us always. He's with us always. declares what we know about bloodline iniquity until Jesus comes in. The sin of the forefathers keeps going, keeps going, keeps going until Christ comes in and stops it. Amen? There you go, right there.

And the only hope we have from that bloodline that came from Adam and Eve all the way through is Jesus Christ and Him crucified for us to receive the atonement, receive the anointing, receive the breakthrough to say, as for me and my house, we will serve the Lord. and I receive the promises in His covenant. Buck stops here.

You can see this in medical, heart disease, heart disease, heart disease, heart disease. Why do you think you have to fill out the forms when you go to the doctor? They understand that on the physical side. Well, it happens in the spiritual, mental, emotional side, and financial side. That is what he's saying. This is what it looks like with humanity.

This was before Jesus Christ. But the prophet knew, God, great and mighty God, Your name is Lord Almighty. See how he's praising Him for who He is? Jeremiah 32:19, great are Your purposes, and mighty are Your deeds. Your eyes are open to all the ways of mankind. God loves us. He sees it all, and His desire is for us to know Him.

With God, all things are possible, Jesus said. With God, all things are possible. He just wants us to believe Him. He wants our heart. And so we get to spend our journey on this side of heaven of having revelation of His goodness, and receive it and apply it to our lives.

Our eyes, His eyes are open to all the ways of mankind. He sees the good and He sees the evil. Mighty are Your deeds. Your eyes are open to all the ways of all mankind, and You will reward each person according to their conduct and as their deeds deserve. That's a fact, and we need that, yes? We need that. Say, I need that. Praise God for Jesus Christ, right?

Okay, look at Isaiah 9:6-7. Great and mighty God. Jesus said, mighty to save. We talked on the Spirit of Might last week. He says, mighty to save. We're building up. Y'all good? The scripture declares His glory.

Isaiah 9:6-7, we love to read this at Christmas, around the birth, but this is who He is. For unto us a child is born, unto us a son is given. and the government will be upon His shoulder, His name will be called Wonderful, Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace, and of the increase of His government and peace, there will be no end. Upon the throne of David and over His kingdom, to order it and to establish it with judgment and with justice. And from that time forward, even forever, and the zeal of the Lord of hosts will perform this.

Hallelujah. That's Jesus Christ, the Son of God, the government of the kingdom of heaven. He carries, He owns, He is Lord over. That is your God. And heaven is our home. Thy kingdom come, Thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven.

Every believer's heart already is in heaven with Him in heavenly places even before we cross over. Yes. He's bringing revelation of this daily. Everything is found in the Son. You've got to think power and full authority. And He's the head over all authorities. He is the head over all kingdoms. He is the head over all governments.

God Almighty raises up and He brings down. If you think of all of the history, it's God Almighty that says, from empire to empire to empire to empire, who rises, who falls. When they rise, when they fall. God Almighty is in charge of all of it. History proves itself.

He is the same yesterday, today, and forever, and He is the Lord God Almighty over the church of Jesus Christ, whom He says, this is my government, and I'm going to impart to you the fullness of the sevenfold spirit, and you're going to carry on my mission. You're going to go out and seek to save the lost. You're going to go into all the nations and preach this gospel.

He wants all of your family members saved, healed, and delivered. He wants to restore everything you've got. He is for you, not against you. He's not sitting up there pointing out

because, you know, He sees all things, pointing on your weakness and making fun of it. He says, No, come to Me. Come to Me and let Me show the sacrifice of My Son and what He has done to heal you. Isn't that good news? Wow.

His name is called Wonderful. So we can just sit and meditate on all these names for a while, but His name is Wonderful. So during the day you can say, Lord God, you are wonderful. That's worship, yes? Counselor. That's why He put counsel and might. The spirit of counsel and might. They always go together. Counselor. He knows you inside out and upside down. Yes, He knows what's in our hearts.

And He will bring the counsel from heaven to empower us and lead us. He is mighty God. Jesus Christ is mighty God. He is mighty to say. Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace. There's no one greater than Him.

Psalm 46:10 is a word He gave us in January in our vision conference. He says, be still and know that I am God. Be still and know that I am God. And that is the believer's hope because we put all of our hope and faith and trust. He is God. Okay? When you put your trust there, not on mankind, not on humans, not on governments, right?

Be still, meditate, think on it, rest and be assured. I am God. Be still and know I am God. I will be exalted in the nations, and I will be exalted in the earth. That's what the Scripture says. That encourages you. That strengthens you, because He is mighty to save. Amen?

He is Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace. Of the increase of His government and peace, there is no end. This government, this kingdom will not stop. It won't stop. It won't stop. You can't destroy it. You can't conquer it. No devil in hell is going to overtake it. Satan is defeated. You understand?

He will go around to kill, steal, and destroy as many as he can on this planet. But God Almighty owns it all, and the government belongs to Jesus Christ. And He's coming again. This is good news. You should be happy. Yes?

There will be no end upon the throne of David and over His kingdom. He's going to give back the promised kingdom to Israel, yes? To Israel and to Jerusalem. And Jesus Christ will reign from that place, yes, forever and ever. There'll be a new heaven and a new earth one day, right? He's going to restore everything. Say, man, we're not even going to recognize each other then. I don't know. Where have we been? But that's going to be good news. Amen.

Upon the throne of David and over His kingdom and ordering it, establishing it with judgment and justice. Very important. Judgment and justice. Judgment and justice. Judgment and justice. They always go together. Because God your Father is always working

things justly and rightly. He judges from the throne. Yes, justice and righteousness are the foundation of His throne.

So He leads the body of Christ into these truths, and He strengthens us. That's why you're called and prompted to do what is good, and to do what is right, and to do what is honest, and to do what is fair. That's why you have a conscience, right? If you've been born again, and when you go over a little bit, He'll correct you. He'll correct you and bring you back into the center of His will. He says, Let me have it.

That's why the Body Cross prays for our leaders. Yes? Prays for those in our leadership at every level of everything. Yes? And God hears our prayer because He gives us the prayers, He gives us the Word, we decree it, we pray it, we intercede, and God moves. Isn't that powerful? In every nation. Truth. He is Lord over all.

Wow, forever and ever. And love this, the zeal of the Lord of hosts will perform this. The zeal, the passion, the fire, the glory of the Lord.

Now, Psalm 50:1, I want to read this out of King James. I'm pulling out where the scripture exalts Him as mighty God. Yes? Psalm 50:1. And so now this lifts your spirit up, versus just, I have to go to church, right?

This is my God. This is my Father. And He sent His Son to save me. And as for me and my house, we will serve this Lord. That's it. That settles it. You're either in or you're out. There is no in-between. You're either in or you're out. And I am in the family of God, and there is a way to walk with Him. That's truth. That's who He is. He's a mighty God who loves us. Wow.

That's why there's a scripture, Train up the children in the ways of the Lord. When He's older, they won't depart from it.

Psalm 50:1, The mighty God, even the Lord, hath spoken and called the earth from the rising of the sun and to the going down thereof. Wow. You know, the astronauts are tripping out in space looking at the earth and the moon. He's like, yeah, yeah. But one day they're going to look to Him and be awe of the one who created the heavens and the earth.

The mighty God, the mighty God, the mighty God, even the Lord has spoken and called the earth from the rising of the sun until the going down thereof. Our Lord Jesus Christ shall come again to establish His righteousness on the earth, hallelujah, and bring praise to Jerusalem for His name's sake.

So if you could go to Isaiah 62:11-12, I'm going to read a portion of this. The whole chapter is glorious. Say, Mighty to save.

Isaiah 62:11-12. It says here, Indeed, the Lord has proclaimed to the end of the world. Who's His audience? Indeed, the Lord has proclaimed to the end of the world, say to the daughter of Zion, surely your salvation is coming. Behold, His reward is with Him, His work before Him, and they shall call them the holy people, the redeemed of the Lord. And you shall be called sought out a city not forsaken.

Truth, now if you could go to Isaiah 63:1-6, I want to read this. And then I'm going to break all this down and bring it together.

Isaiah 63:1. The little subtitle says, Vengeance of God. I'm glad I'm on His side. Okay. Isaiah 63:1, Who is this who comes from Edom with dyed garments from Bozrah? This one who is glorious in His apparel, traveling in the greatness of His strength. I who speak in righteousness, mighty to save.

Why is Your apparel red, and Your garments like one who treads in the winepress? I have trodden the winepress alone, and from the peoples no one was with Me. For I have trodden them in My anger, and I trampled them in My fury. Their blood is sprinkled upon My garments, and I have stained on My robes.

Isaiah 63:4-6, For the day of vengeance is in My heart, and the year of My redeemed has come. I looked, but there was no one to help. And I wondered that there was no one to uphold. Therefore My own arm brought salvation for Me. And My own fury, it sustained Me. I have trodden down the peoples in My anger and made them drunk in My fury and brought down their strength to the earth. Wow.

These verses depict God's future judgment. on an ungodly world. These scriptures point to God's future judgment on an ungodly world. Edom represents all the world powers that are opposed to God and His people. This prediction will be fulfilled at the end of the cosmic activity that occurs at the end of the Great Tribulation.

The Lord's garments are stained red with the blood of the wicked. 13, which we'll read in a moment, Christ's robe is pictured as dipped in blood, as He returns to the earth to destroy the wicked. God Himself will wage war against the nations and defeat them. He will trample them as a people trample grapes in the winepress.

Now, Isaiah 63:1, I'm going to go through this. This is what He said, mighty to save. I found it in one place, and it's in this Scripture. Every other Scripture says in the Spirit of might, He's mighty God, you understand? Honor and might, power and glory is His, but here He's called this mighty to save.

Isaiah 63:1, Who is this who comes from Edom? with dyed garments from Bozrah, this one who is glorious in His apparel, traveling in the greatness of His strength. I who speak in righteousness, mighty to save.

And He has been mighty to save me. He's been mighty to save you. Yes? As for me and my house, we will serve this Lord. Truth? I who speak in righteousness, mighty to save. For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, right, that whoever would believe in Him would not perish, but have everlasting life. He is so mighty He gave of Himself. He proved it. He sure did. Yes, He sure did.

I, who speak in righteousness, mighty to save. I want you just to hear this out of this other translation. Just listen. This is from the Complete Jewish Study Bible. It says, Who is this coming from Edom? from Bozrah with clothing stained in crimson, so magnificently dressed, so stately in His great strength. It is I who speak victoriously, I will be able to save.

You feel that strength? Who is this coming from Edom from Bozrah with clothing stained crimson, so magnificently dressed, so stately in His great strength? It is I who speak victoriously, I will be able to save.

Same verse out of the Amplified Classic. Just listen. Who is this who comes from Edom with crimson stained garments from Bozrah in Edom? This one who is glorious in His apparel, striding triumphantly in the greatness of His might. It is I, the one who speaks in righteousness, proclaiming vindication. Mighty to save. Wow.

Now, if you put that in line in the other scripture we just read, it's coming together. Yes, great and mighty God is an understatement. Where do you find the word? Jesus. He fulfills it all. Amen. Who is this one? I who speak in righteousness, victory, vindication. I am mighty to save.

Isaiah 63:2-3, Why is Your apparel red, and Your garments like one who treads in the winepress? I have trodden the winepress alone, and from the peoples no one was with Me. For I have trodden them in My anger, I trampled them in My fury. Their blood is sprinkled upon My garments, and I have stained all My robes.

Now, if you could go to Joel 3:12-13, bring a little support here. All these prophets saw the same thing, and some of them saw it in a different way. Everybody got a glimpse of glory, a glimpse of glory, a glimpse, a revelation. And all together through the scripture, He reveals who He is. Whoa, isn't that wonderful?

Joel 3:12-13. He said, Let the nations be awakened. Come up to the valley of Jehoshaphat, for there I will sit to judge all the surrounding nations. Put in the sickle, for the harvest is ripe. Come, go down, for the winepress is full, and the vats overflow, for their wickedness

is great. God Almighty will deal with wickedness once and for all through His righteous judgments. Amen?

Now go to Revelation 14:17-20. These all go together. Of course, you can read it all on your own. My subtitle says, Reaping the Grapes of Wrath.

Revelation 14:17-18, Then another angel came out of the temple which is in heaven. He also having a sharp sickle. And another angel came out from the altar who had the power over fire, and He cried out with a loud cry to Him who had the sharp sickle, saying, Thrust in Your sharp sickle, gather the clusters of the vine of the earth, for her grapes are fully ripe.

Revelation 14:19-20, And so the angel thrust his sickle into the earth and gathered the vine of the earth, and threw it into the great winepress of the wrath of God. And the winepress was trampled outside of the city, and blood came out of the winepress up to the horses' bridles for 1,600 furlongs. Wow.

Now back to Isaiah 63:4. For the day of vengeance is in My heart, and the year of My redeemed has come.

Isaiah 63:5, I looked, but there was no one to help. I wondered that there was no one to uphold. Therefore, My own arm brought salvation for Me. My own fury, it sustained Me, and that fury is the zeal of the Lord. That fury is jealous. Yes, that's His name. Jealous, mighty God, perfect love. He is going to deal with all wickedness perfectly. Amen? That should encourage you. Don't worry, God's got it.

Isaiah 63:5, I looked, but there was nobody to help, and I wondered that there was no one to uphold. Therefore, My own arm brought salvation for Me, the strong arm of the Lord. My own fury, it sustained Me. Say, perfect fury. Perfect vindication. Not humans.

Isaiah 63:6, I have trodden down the peoples in My anger and made them drunk in My fury and brought down their strength to the earth. Christ will use the sword of God's word that proceeds from His mouth when He returns to destroy Israel's enemies.

So now we go to Revelation 19:11-21. We'll close, whoa, here. Maybe. Mighty to save. And so when He says that He's given unto us the fullness of the Spirit, He gives His counsel and might, remember? Might's a big word. All of it works together for good. All these things work together for good for us who love Him, that this is who He says He is, that He will deal righteously once and for all.

Revelation 19:11-12, my subtitle said Christ on a White Horse. It says, Now I saw heaven opened, and behold a white horse, and He who sat on Him was called Faithful and True,

and in righteousness He judges and makes war. His eyes were like a flame of fire, and on His head were many crowns. He had a name written that no one knew except Himself.

Revelation 19:13-16, He was clothed with a robe dipped in blood, and His name is called the Word of God. And the armies in heaven, clothed in fine linen, white and clean, followed Him on white horses. And now out of His mouth goes a sharp sword, that with it He should strike the nations, and He Himself will rule them with a rod of iron. He Himself, glory to God, treads the winepress of the fierceness and the wrath of Almighty God. He has on His robe and on His thigh name written, King of Kings and Lord of Lords.

Revelation 19:17-18, And then I saw an angel standing in the sun, and He cried out with a loud voice, saying to all the birds that fly in the midst of the heaven, 'Come, let us gather together for the supper of the great God, that you may eat the flesh of kings and the flesh of captains, the flesh of mighty men, the flesh of horses and of those who sit on them, and the flesh of all people, free and slave, both small and great.'

Revelation 19:19, And I saw the beast, the kings of the earth, and their armies gathered together to make war against Him who sat on the horse and against His army. How dumb can you be? Brandy interpretation.

Revelation 19:20, Then the beast was captured, and with him the false prophet who worked signs in his presence, by which he deceived those who received the mark of the beast and those who worshiped his image. These two were cast alive into the lake of fire, burning with brimstone.

Revelation 19:21. And the rest were killed with the sword, which proceeded from the mouth of Him who sat on the horse. And all the birds were filled with their flesh. Perfect vindication. Perfect justice. Perfect in all His ways. Mighty to save.

The Lord exhorts us in the spirit of counsel and might, in the spirit of might. We cannot rely upon our own strength, but yet our flesh needs to obey the Lord. But we look to our mighty God.

Praise the Lord, those who are in Jesus Christ, those who've been saved and blood washed, we are not appointed to wrath. Say it, I am not appointed to wrath. That is good news. Jesus Christ came so we would not be appointed to wrath, not my future. not my future. Say, Hallelujah. Because Jesus took the wrath of God for me.

But He will be perfect and zealous and He will finish what He started on the day that Almighty God says, Now go, son. Do you understand? Everything has to be fulfilled perfectly until you can't just leave at the end of the book and, well, one day we receive of

the Spirit of might today. We worship the mighty God today. We apply that He is mighty to save today.

We receive Him to our marriage, finances, health, family, everything in the ministry we're set to do, everything. As we pray for the nations, many will repent. Many will repent. Many that you didn't think would ever come to Christ will come, and many will fall away, many will be hardened, and meaner will get meaner still, right? The darkness will get darker, but the light is growing stronger and stronger until the coming day.

He exhorts us. I am mighty to save. He is mighty God. He is mighty God. He is mighty God. He is mighty to save. I who speaks in righteousness, mighty to save. That means me today. Not just from distant miracle in the future. Do you understand?

This is our Lord and Savior today. He beckons us to look to Him. He calls us, Be strong in the Lord in the power of His might. Be strong in the Lord in the power of His might. And that lifts up your heart. It lifts up your head. It gives you courage just reading it. Here's my weakness, Lord. Here's my need, Lord. Here's my heart, Lord. And He will come.

So he says, Take up the whole armor of God, be clothed in Him so you can withstand in the evil day. Having done all, stand. That's your mighty God. Stand. Yes?
